Within EITC guidelines, FB Scholarship Services provides scholarships to private schools within Pennsylvania. Our goal is to assist families who choose to educate their children in private and religious schools.

Distribution of funds is needs-based according to family size, income, and tuition owed. (Family income not to exceed \$105,183 plus \$18,514 for each dependent)

The maximum amount of financial aid for a family shall not exceed 70% of the tuition per student.

Scholarships are available for any full-time student (PA resident attending a PA school).

Application Process

- ♦ The school needs to file its information with Faith Builder Scholarship Services.
- ♦ The family needs to complete an application from Faith Builders Scholarship Services for available scholarship funds.
- ♦ Funds for any qualified student will be paid directly to their participating school.

Students who withdraw from the participating school mid-term will have their scholarship funds discontinued and prorated according to the number days in attendance.

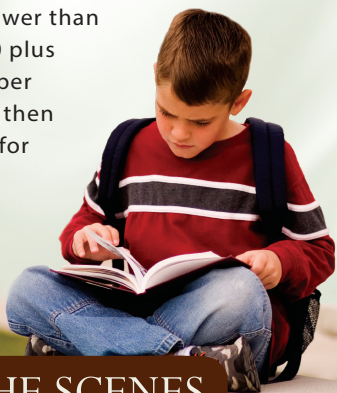

BEHIND THE SCENES

PA ACT 4 OF 2001 AND ACT 48 OF 2003 established the Pennsylvania Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC). This provides tax credits to eligible businesses that contribute to a scholarship organization. If businesses contribute to our scholarship fund and designate their contribution for scholarships to your school, money is available for tuition assistance.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

1. Each parent must first determine eligibility. The combined adjusted gross income of a household cannot exceed \$105,183 plus \$18,514 per depend.
- For example: If a family has three dependents, then their household income must not exceed \$160,725 to qualify for assistance.
2. If your family is eligible, and if our Scholarship Services has received contributions designated for your school, the next step is to complete a family application. You can obtain a family applications from your school administration.
3. Send the completed family application directly to Faith Builders Scholarship Services, 28527 Guys Mills Rd., Guys Mills, PA 16327.
4. After receiving your family application, Faith Builders will respond by sending you a confirmation notice. This notifies you that the information from your application has been entered into our database.
5. After the application process is completed, you will be notified of the amount of scholarship assistance for your family. The timing of this notice depends on when the money becomes available for your school and on the family application deadline. Normally, you should receive notice of the amount of your assistance for the given year by December 30.
6. The scholarship assistance for your family is sent directly to the school.
7. The last step of this scholarship assistance process is gratitude and thanksgiving. We provide you with a gratitude postcard for every contributor that sponsors the scholarship awards. These Gratitude Postcards will be sent along with the Scholarship Notice. As a scholarship organization, Faith Builders believes that gratitude toward contributors is an important virtue. We ask you to be thoughtful and authentic as you write a note of thanksgiving to the business that invested in your school.
